Please don't hesitate to call any member of the Graphics staff if you have questions about any of the specifications displayed or for other compositional guidance. We are at your service.

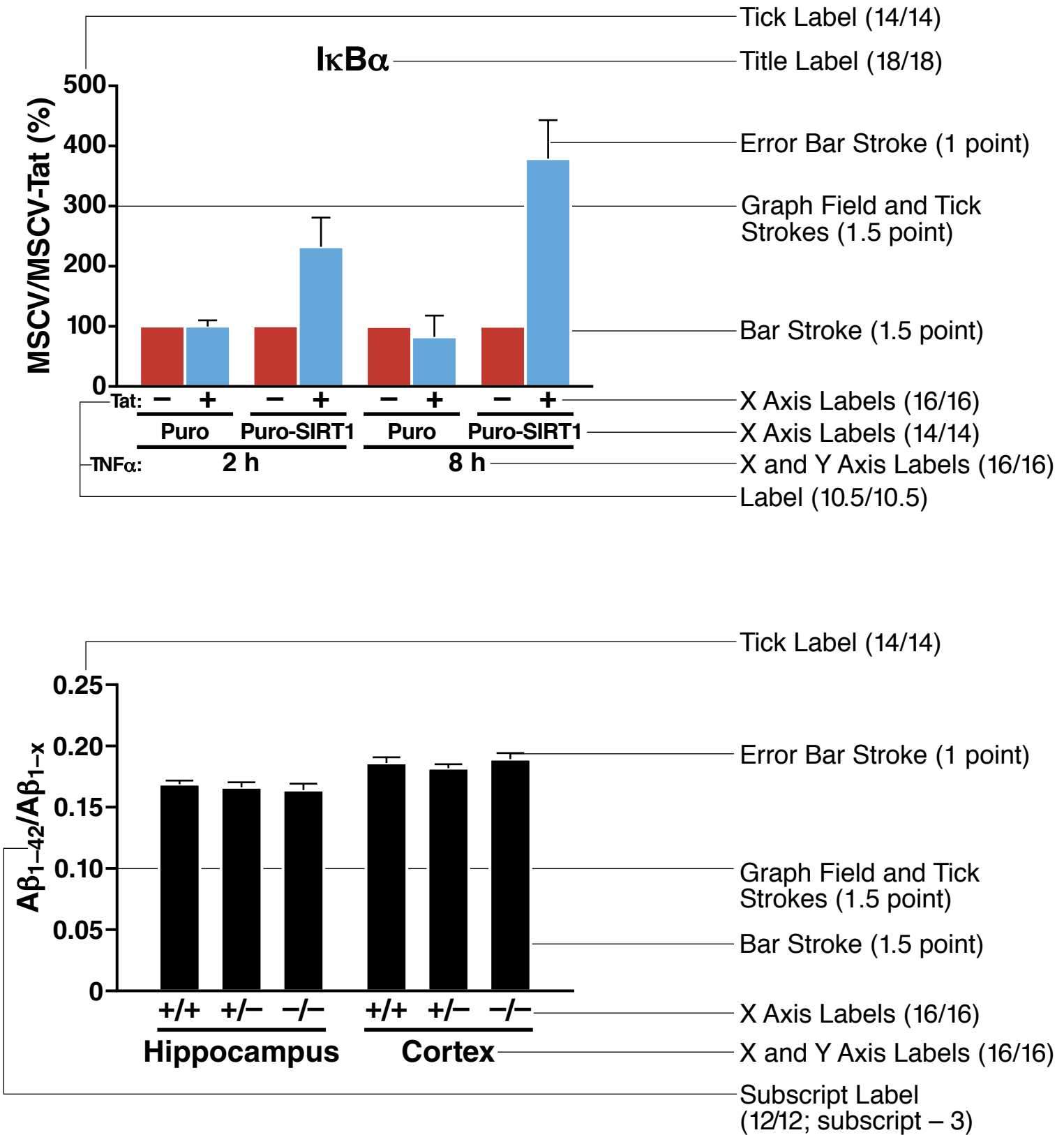

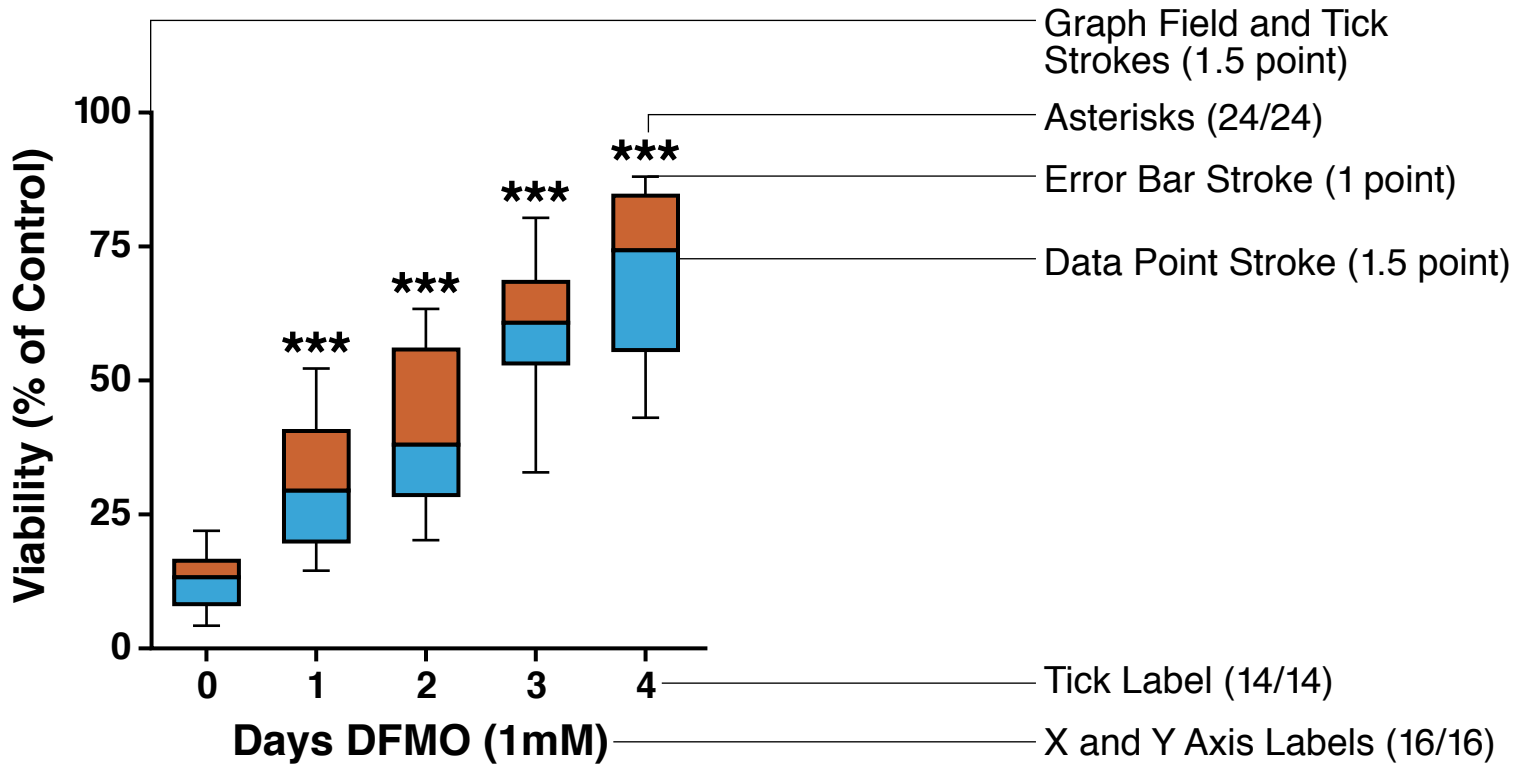
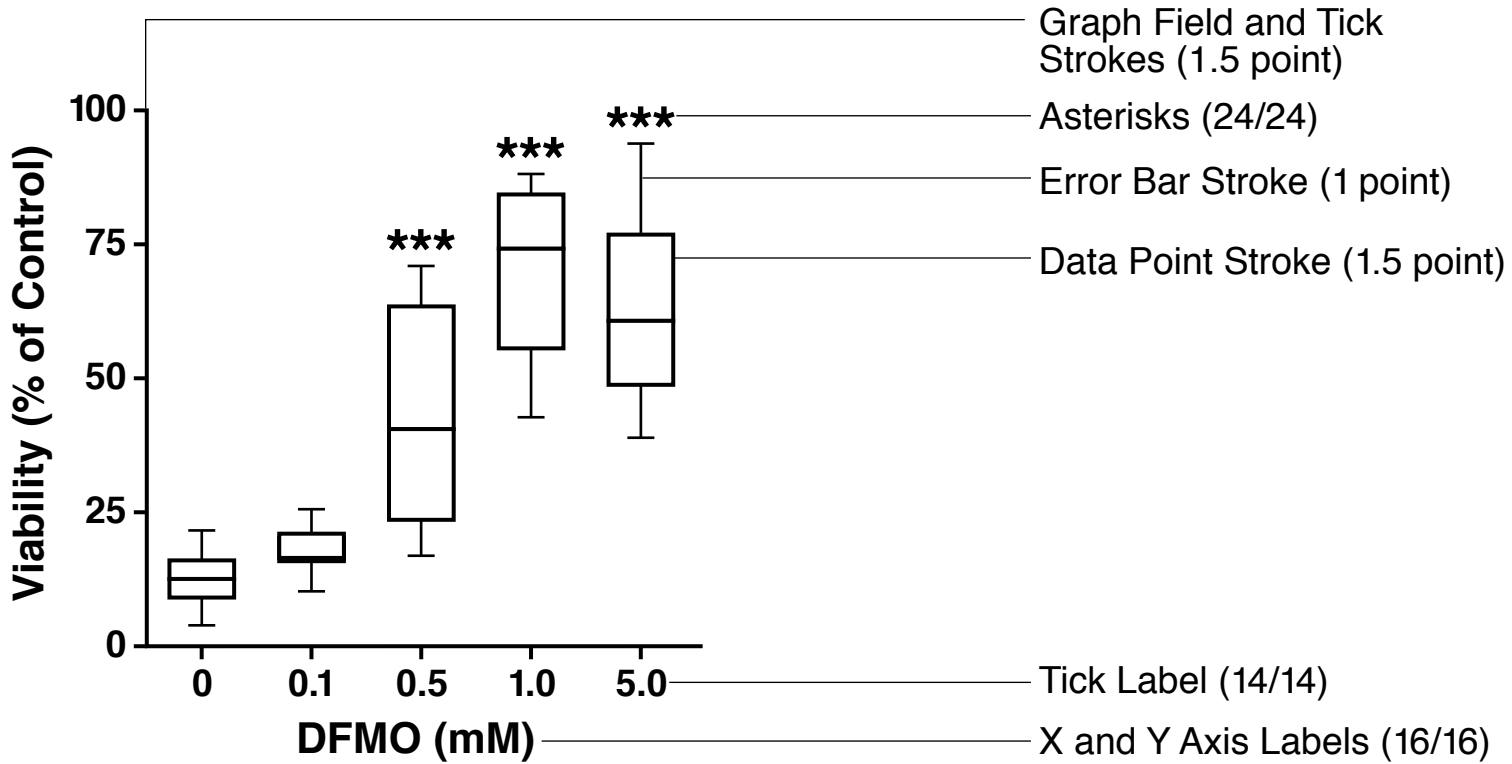
# Scatter Graph



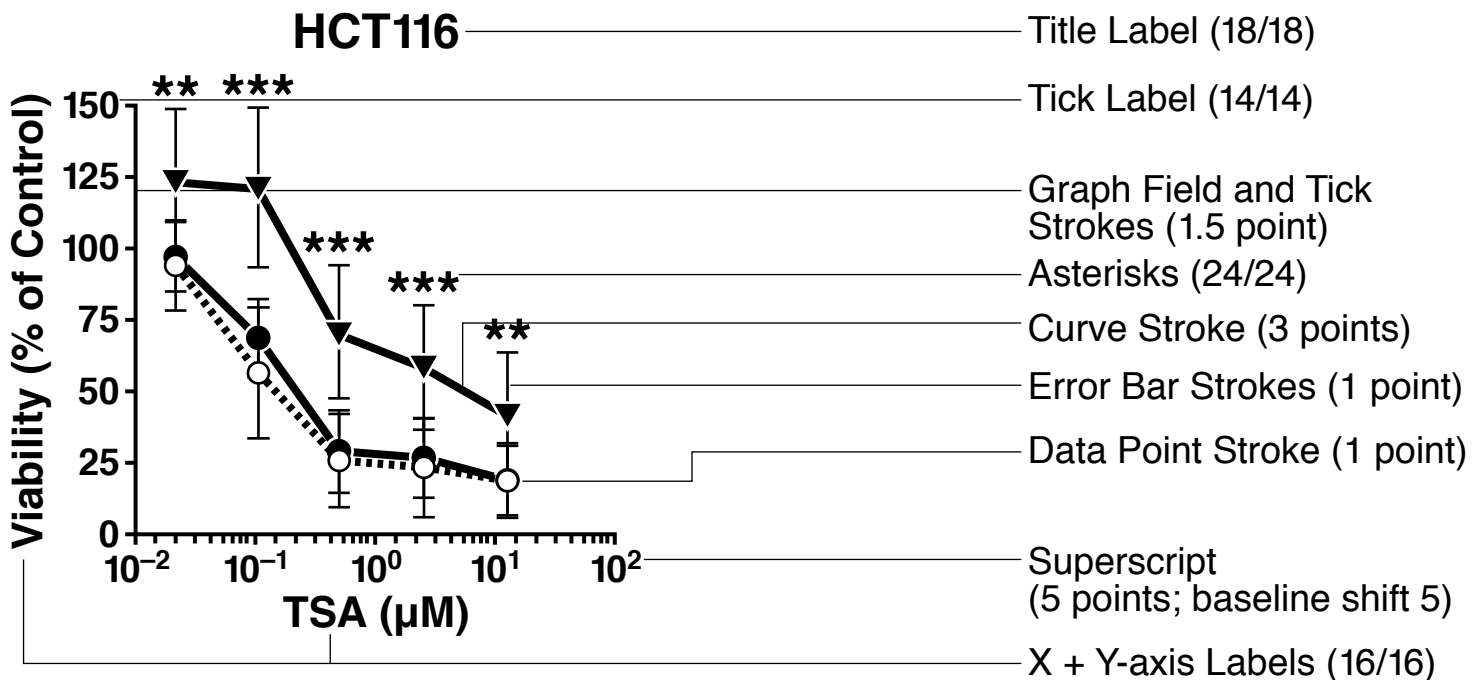
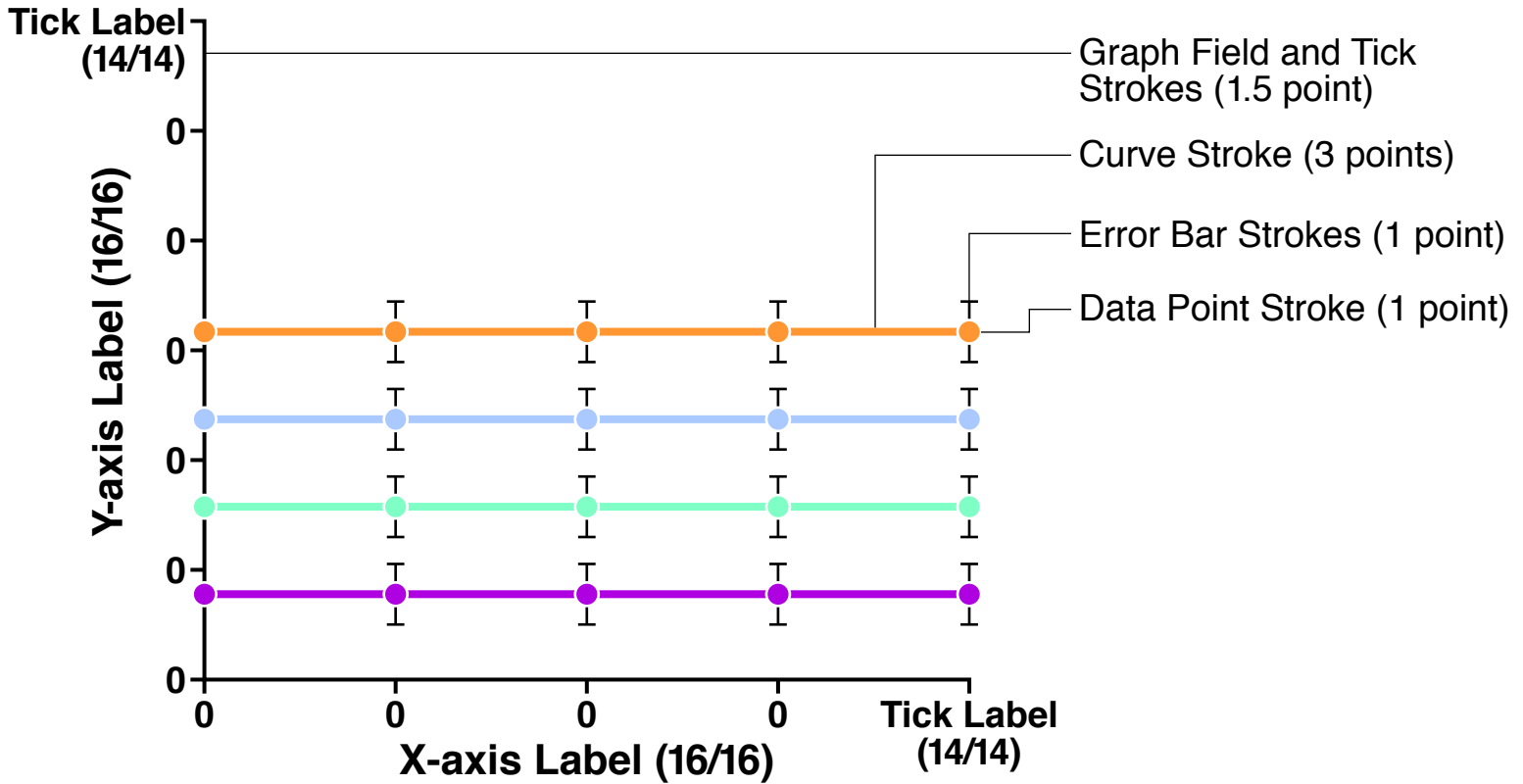

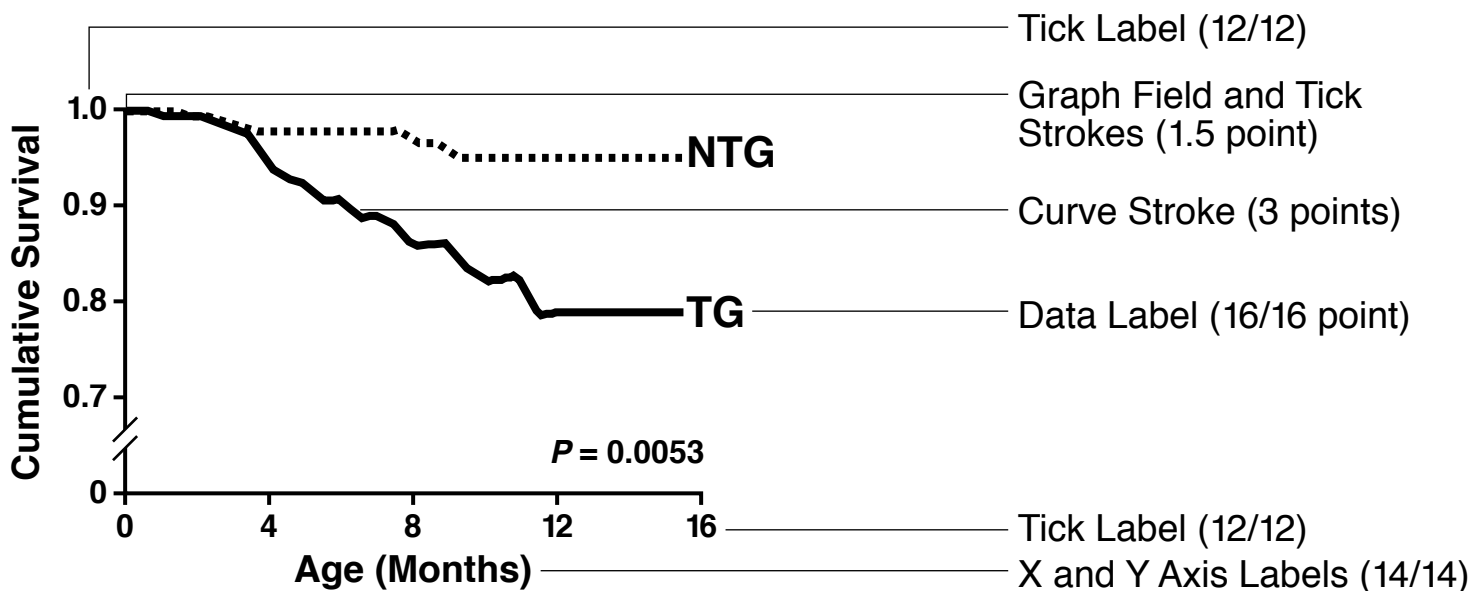
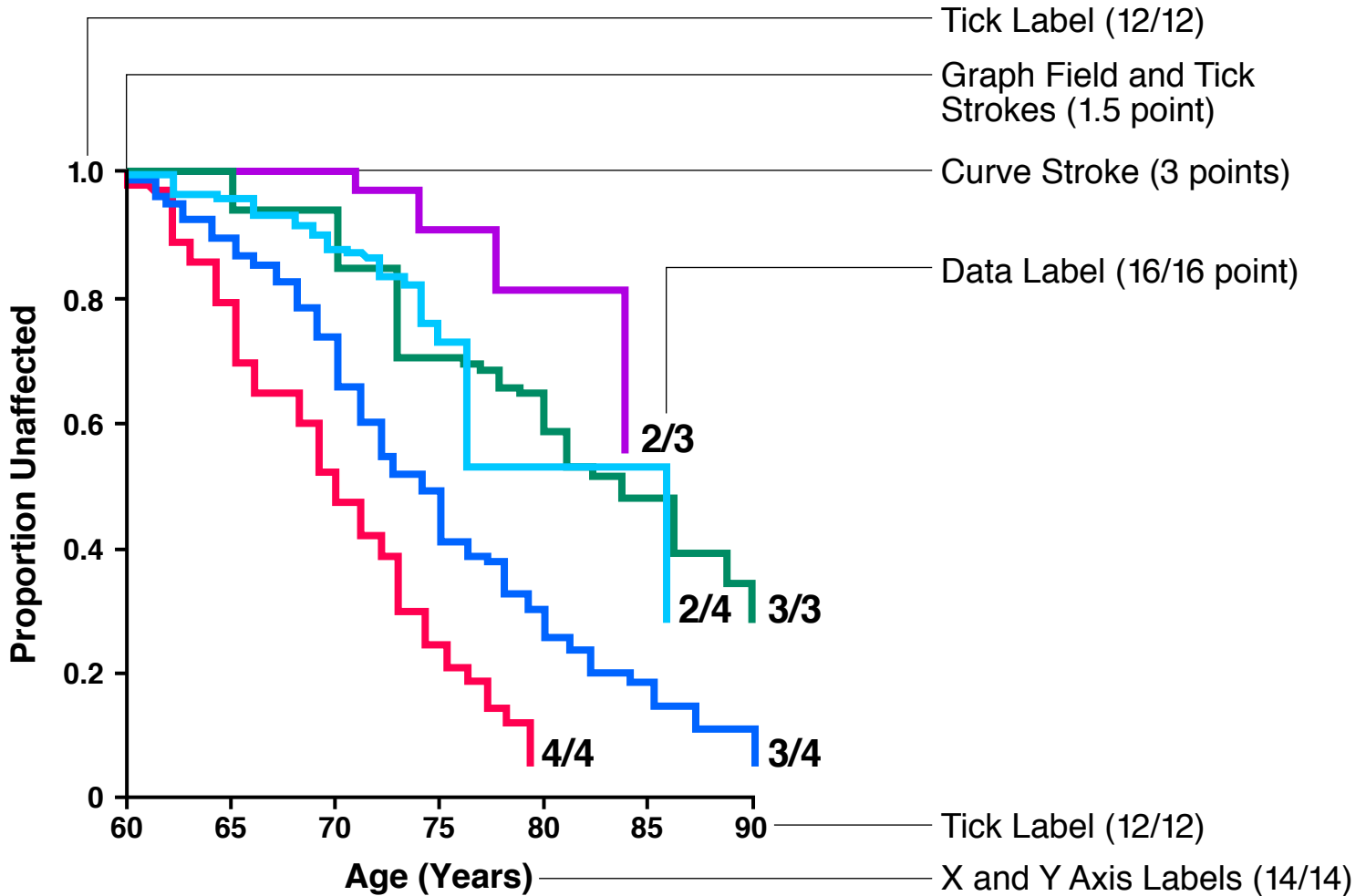
# Multivariate Curve Graphs

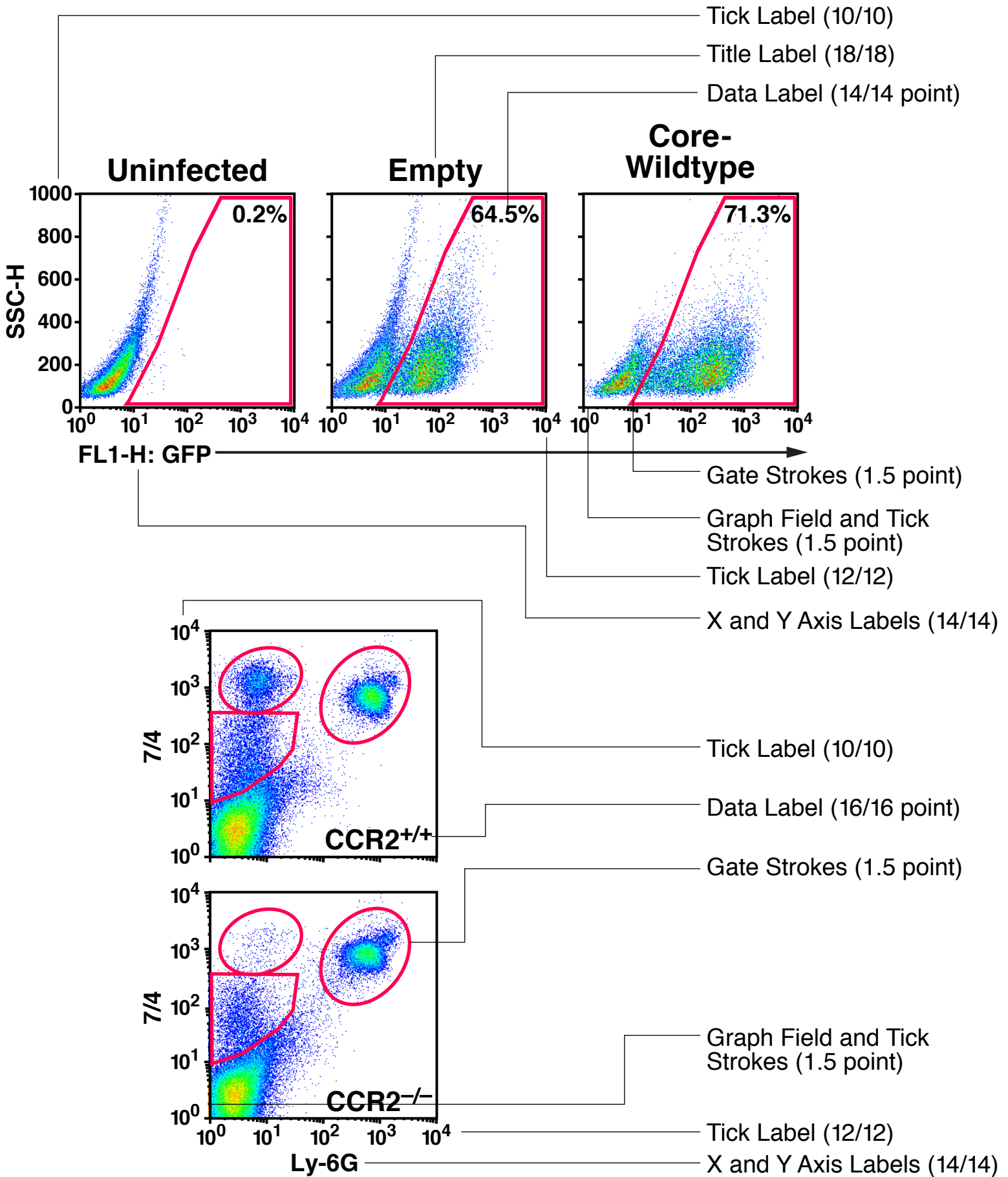


# Cascading Line Graph
